The Wairakei Power Station is owned and operated by Contact Energy Limited, who produce 25% of NZ's electricity. The Station is an important national generator of electricity.

The Crown owns the geothermal resource itself.

Saturday morning the conference starts bright and early in the Heritage Room with presentations on an interesting array of topics including keynote speaker Dr. Hathibelagal Roshan from Wisconsin USA. Dr Roshan has a PhD in Metallurgy specialising in Casting Technology, he is President of Intellectual Capital Exchange LLC and Chief Metallurgist of Maynard Steel Casting Company. He also holds academic positions at the University of Wisconsin, Banu Learning Systems and AFS Cast Metal Institute.

Finishing with pre dinner drinks in the House Bar and buffet dinner in Graham Room 1 at the hotel.
